# The growing plastic, packaging and printing industry

The Indian economy, one of the world's largest and fastest growing, has witnessed robust growth rates in the last few years. At the forefront of this progress is the plastic industry, which has emerged as a vital segment of the country's economy.

The Indian plastic industry ranks third in the world for both plastic consumption and single use plastic production. The current size of India's plastic industry, which employs more than 4 million people, is estimated to be Rs. 3 lakh crore. It comprises more than 30,000 processing units manufacturing different products like housewares, cordage, medical items, pipes, films, raw materials and packaging items.

Packaging is one of the major constituents of the plastic industry which drives industrial growth and innovation. It is the fifth largest sector in the Indian economy that is constantly evolving while leveraging technological innovations and sustainable practices. It is expected to reach USD 204.81 billion by year 2025.

The commercial printing sector is another major player that ensures inevitable growth of the Indian market. It is driven primarily by the development of innovative printing technologies by the manufacturers. An industry with the market size of USD 34.5 billion has the potential to reach 45.3 billion by the year 2032. The focus shift towards engineered products with a reduced carbon footprint, high energy efficiency, better resistance to chemicals and transition to digital technology have provided significant growth to the market.
